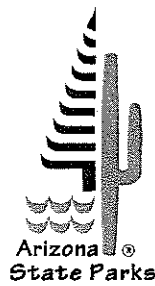

- B. CALL TO THE PUBLIC** - The public is invited to make a statement to the subcommittee regarding the meeting topics.
- C. DISCUSSION ITEMS** - Action is limited to selecting individuals to do further research on the issue and directing staff to include the item on a future agenda for appropriate action.
 - 1) An overview of the State's Open Meeting Law.
 - 2) Reviewing the current criteria for trails to be in the State Trail System (STS).
 - 3) Developing a methodology for determining if trails listed in the Guide still meet the criteria for being in the STS.
 - 4) Developing criteria and requirements for being listed in the Guide.
 - 5) Identifying the types of information and criteria that should be listed in the Guide.
 - 6) Identifying opportunities and constraints of updating the Guide for landowners/managers and State Parks.
 - 7) Developing a strategic plan for gathering updated information, updating the Guide, and distributing the information (types of format, locations, time frames, potential costs).

- 8) Identify areas for further investigation and discussion for next subcommittee meeting in late-November. Determine Action Items and responsibilities.
