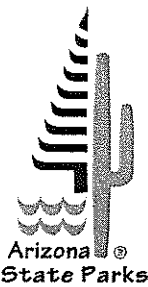

1. The committee will continue the discussion on what the future State Trail System (STS) should look like, what the nomination criteria for trails should be, and what will be the best method to store and promote the new STS database.

2. The committee will identify what needs to be done to maintain the integrity of the current State Trail System trails, i.e. how to archive/library the current system.

3. The committee will discuss what consideration trails in the State Trail System should receive in future grant project funding evaluation.
