Looking for new trails to ride? Are you new to off-highway vehicle scene in Arizona? Have you recently purchased an ATV, UTV, or dirt bike and want to know where to ride? The Arizona Off-Highway Vehicle Ambassadors are offering a chance for you to come out, meet us and get to know some new riding areas. This free “Show Me” type experience will introduce you to the area by reviewing maps, explaining the types of trails available in the area, review proper riding etiquette/safety information, and taking a ride around the area with the OHV Ambassadors and their decades of experience. These rides are open to users of all skill levels, riding abilities, and riding knowledge. Bring your ATV, UTV, Dirt Bike or 4x4 off-highway vehicle and be ready to hit the trail. We recommend arriving at the staging area listed at least 30 minutes prior to the ride start time.

Date/Time	Location	Vehicle Types	Directions to Staging Area
Sunday, September 10th, 2017	Las Cienegas National Conservation Area – Tucson Area	All Vehicle Types	Las Cienegas is located 45 miles southeast of Tucson, Arizona. From Tucson, drive southeast on Interstate 10 to Exit 281. Head south on State Highway 83. Near milepost 40, turn east into the Empire Ranch entrance. Watch for entrance signage. We will meet at 7:00am at the information kiosk that is about a 1/4 mile in from the highway. From there we will caravan to the preferred OHV staging area, which is at the old airstrip. If you know where that is just meet us there.
Sunday, September 17th, 2017	Coconino	Dirt Bikes Only	We will stage at the junction of Forest roads 3E and 867A. Get there by traveling down Lake Mary Road (exit from I-17 on south end of Flagstaff) to Frontier Road. (about 3 miles) Frontier will be on the right side of the road. Frontier goes about 1/4 until you run into Forest Road 3E on the left. From there travel 1/2 mile down the 3E to the junction with Forest Road 876A road on the left. We will stage there, and plan to ride at 9:00 am. GPS Coordinates: N 35.1318° W 111.6526°
Saturday, September 23rd, 2017 – 10:00AM	Camp Wood – Prescott Area	ATV & UTV	From I-17 take Exit 262 onto AZ 69 toward Prescott. Continue 21 miles on AZ69, through Mayer and Dewey-Humbolt, to Fain Rd, and turn right (North). Continue on Fain Rd 7 miles onto AZ89A Westbound. Continue on AZ89A Westbound 7 miles and continue straight onto Pioneer Parkway. Continue on Pioneer Parkway 4.5 miles to Williamson Valley Rd, and turn right (North). Continue on Williamson Valley Rd 19.5 miles to intersection with Camp Wood Rd (County Rd 5). Stage in the dirt area on the Southwest corner. Coordinates are N 34.832054° W 112.647757°.
Saturday, October 21st, 2017 – 9:00AM	Bumble Bee Area	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	Directions to Bumble Bee staging area: From I-17, north of Black Canyon City, take exit 248. Cross over the interstate on frontage road. Follow the winding pavement downhill until it turns to dirt. Continue north 0.7miles to the staging area kiosk board on the left. Ambassadors will meet you at the single panel kiosk board.
Saturday October 28th, 2017 – 9:00AM	Backroad to Crown King	Full size 4x4	Directions to the Bradshaw Mountains OHV Staging Area— Driving west on SR74 Carefree Hwy, turn north on Castle Hot Springs Rd toward Lake Pleasant at mile marker 17.5. Follow Castle Hot Springs Road to the end of the pavement. Continue on dirt 3 miles and turn right at Cow Creek Rd. Drive 2 miles on Cow Creek Rd to the kiosk board on the right.
Sunday, November 5th, 2017 – 10:00am	Jackass Flats – Morristown	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	Drive west on SR74 Carefree Hwy toward Wickenburg, turn north on Castle Hot Springs Rd near mile marker 2 for approximately 1.5 miles to the parking area on your right. Alternative parking is available at 2.0 miles and 2.3 miles. Note: A State Land Permit is required to park in this area...to get your state land permit visit: https://land.az.gov/natural-resources/recreational-permits .
Friday, November 24th, 2017 – 10:00AM	Boulders OHV Area	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	Take SR74 (Carefree Highway) West from I-17 past Lake Pleasant to milepost 11.5. Turn North onto well graded dirt road for approximately 1 mile. The OHV Ambassadors will meet you in the south end of the staging area at the 3-panel kiosk.
Sunday December 3rd, 2017 – 10:00AM	Vulture Mountains – Morristown	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	From the intersection of US60 and Gates Road in Morristown head west just past the railroad tracks. There is parking on the left and the right side of gates road just past the railroad tracks.
Saturday, December 16th, 2017 – 9:00AM	Table Mesa East – New River Area	ATV & UTV	Little Pan Staging Areas - Take the Table Mesa Road Exit on I-17 just north of New River, turn west and then take frontage road North. Follow Table Mesa Road staying right at the first two forks. Take a left at the third fork and follow to the staging area. Staging area is approximately 4 miles west from I17. Ambassadors will meet you at the main kiosk near the rest room.
