Looking for new trails to ride? Are you new to off-highway vehicle scene in Arizona? Have you recently purchased an ATV, UTV, or dirt bike and want to know where to ride? The Arizona Off-Highway Vehicle Ambassadors are offering a chance for you to come out, meet us and get to know some new riding areas. This free “Show Me” type experience will introduce you to the area by reviewing maps, explaining the types of trails available in the area, review proper riding etiquette/safety information, and taking a ride around the area with the OHV Ambassadors and their decades of experience. These rides are open to users of all skill levels, riding abilities, and riding knowledge. Bring your ATV, UTV, Dirt Bike or 4x4 off-highway vehicle and be ready to hit the trail. We recommend arriving at the staging area listed at least 30 minutes prior to the ride start time.

Date/Time	Location	Vehicle Types	Directions to Staging Area
Saturday, October 20th, 2018 – 9:30AM	Boulders OHV Area	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	Take SR74 (Carefree Highway) West from I-17 past Lake Pleasant to milepost 11.5. Turn North onto well graded dirt road for approximately 1 mile. The OHV Ambassadors will meet you in the south end of the staging area at the 3-panel kiosk.
Saturday, November 3 rd , 2018 – 9:00AM	Jackass Flats – Morristown	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	Drive west on SR74 Carefree Hwy toward Wickenburg, turn north on Castle Hot Springs Rd near mile marker 2 for approximately 1.5 miles to the parking area on your right. Alternative parking is available at 2.0 miles and 2.3 miles. Note: A State Land Permit is required to park in this area...to get your state land permit visit: https://land.az.gov/natural-resources/recreational-permits
Sunday, November 18 th , 2018 – 9:30AM	Bumble Bee Area	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	Directions to Bumble Bee staging area: From I-17, north of Black Canyon City, take exit 248. Cross over the interstate on frontage road. Follow the winding pavement downhill until it turns to dirt. Continue north 0.7miles to the staging area kiosk board on the left. Ambassadors will meet you at the single panel kiosk board.
Sunday December 2 nd , 2018 – 10:00AM	Vulture Mountains – Morristown	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	From the intersection of US60 and Gates Road in Morristown head west just past the railroad tracks. There is parking on the left and the right side of Gates road just past the railroad tracks.
Saturday December 15 th , 2018 – 9:30AM	Table Mesa East – New River Area	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	Little Pan Staging Areas - Take the Table Mesa Road Exit on I-17 just north of New River, turn west and then take frontage road North. Follow Table Mesa Road staying right at the first two forks. Take a left at the third fork and follow to the staging area. Staging area is approximately 4 miles west from I17. Ambassadors will meet you at the main kiosk near the rest room.
Saturday, January 19 th , 2019 – 10:00am	Lake Pleasant Area	ATV, UTV, Dirt Bikes	Driving west on SR74 Carefree Hwy, turn north on Castle Hot Springs Rd toward Lake Pleasant at mile marker 17.5. Follow Castle Hot Springs Road to the end of the pavement. Continue on dirt 3 miles and turn right at Cow Creek Rd. Drive 2 miles on Cow Creek Rd to the kiosk board on the right.
Saturday, February 9 th , 2018 9:00AM	Kofa Area	ATV/UTV	Follow I-10 west to Hovatter Road, Exit #53. Head south on Hovatter Road for approximately .25 miles to large vacant lot on the west side of the road just before the canal. GPS Coordinates: 33 36.124, 113 37.340 There will be RV camping available for those interested starting on 1/26/2018 through 1/28/2018 at approximately 1.3 miles south of the staging area.
Saturday April 20 th , 2018 9:30AM	West Sedona	ATV/UTV/Full Size 4WD -each vehicle type will have a unique route	West Sedona, AZ - from I-17 near Camp Verde take exit #287 for AZ-260 towards Cottonwood. Continue on AZ-260 west for 12.4 miles to AZ-89A North. Follow AZ-89 North for 8.9 Miles to Forest Road 525 (also known as Angel Valley Rd.) on the west side of 89A. Take Forest Road 525 for approximately .3 miles to staging area on your left. The Ambassadors will meet you in the staging area.
Saturday May 4 th , 2018 9:30AM	Stoneman Lake Area	ATV/UTV	Follow I-17 North to Stoneman Lake Rd (exit 306). Follow Stoneman Lake Road east for approximately 8.5 miles to the T-Intersection. Turn right on forest road 213 and the staging area will be on the right.
Saturday June 1 st , 2018 9:30AM	Big Lake Area	ATV/UTV	Staging area to be posted soon. There will be RV camping available for those interested starting on 5/31/2018 through 6/3/2018.
